

Cyx Volta

A robotic system for safe live overhead power line maintenance

REDUCED HSE RISKS

Maintenance on energized overhead electrical lines exposes personnel to serious hazards, including burns, electrocution, and falls from height. Cyx Volta eliminates these risks through use of remotely operated robotics arms.

The remote control station has been carefully engineered for ergonomic comfort, allowing the operator (pilot) to work efficiently with reduced physical strain and improved overall control during extended operations.



LOWER OPEX

The manpower required to perform safe maintenance on overhead lines is significantly reduced, lowering operational cost.



IMPROVED AVAILABILITY

Intervention without de-energizing the overhead line becomes possible, unlocking productivity gains while ensuring continuous power to the network.



MODULAR DESIGN

The system can be installed on standard vehicles, optimizing CAPEX and avoiding the addition of extra assets to the operator's fleet.



EASY ADOPTION

The electric robotic dexterous arms are highly maneuverable, enabling ease of use and rapid adoption by field teams.

- Customizable carrier (e.g., spider robot, standard truck or other vehicle)
- Remote control command station powered by Cyxense Commander, a T.EN Marseille technology
